

ART REQUIREMENTS



ART PAPER PROVIDED BY S1A

- Use one sheet per artwork and/or student.
- Unused paper may be saved for future fundraisers.
- Think green and recycle unused paper.

HELPFUL ARTWORK TIPS

- Fill the space with vivid, bold colors and backgrounds.
- Keep picture centered in the space with less important background details at the edges.
- Use Signature Template document provided or write signature and/or date 1 inch from the edges.
- Borders, if colored, can be solid or designs and should be at least1 inch thick.



MATERIALS RECOMMENDED

Markers - Tempera Paint - Intense Watercolors - Crayons - Oil Crayons Paper Collage

FILL OUT ARTIST IDENTIFICATION

- Print information in black or blue ink.
 - No cursive.
 - o Do not allow young children to fill out this information.
- Fill in the School's name on every piece of art submitted.
- We recommend affixing preprinted ID labels to the header section. 12 pt. font is recommended.
- Correct spelling on personalized catalogs depends on legible and accurate information.

FINISHING TOUCHES

- Check artist identification to make sure information is correct and legible.
- Use a fine-tipped marker to overwrite and correct header information.
- Erase unwanted marks, pencil marks and smudges.
- Recolor or repaint lightly colored areas. Light artwork will not reproduce well.
- Skin tones must be heavily covered and opaque as possible.
- Trim away excess paper that hangs over the edges on a paper collage.
