Meet At Whipple Hill: Take Maple Street past Harrington School. Continue across Lowell Street where Maple Street becomes Winchester Drive. Drive just past the top of the hill. Parking lot is on the right by the speed limit sign. (Additional parking across the street.) Bring binoculars if you have them.
